> Love is In the Air • The flower girl gave the bride a hand with her veil on a windy terrace at the Bowery Hotel. Bouquets of 'Black Baccara,' 'Black Magic,' and 'Black Beauty' roses, miniature calla lilies, autumn-tinged hydrangeas, and hypericum berries complemented the bridal party's wine-colored dresses.

2» Pear Do I Sit? • Table assignments on cards tucked in Seckel pears added to the harvest feel of the seated-dinner reception.

>>>> Rose Rows • Every other pew at St. Joseph's Yorkville church was dressed with a bouquet of roses, hydrangeas, hypericum berries, seeded eucalyptus, and trailing ivy.

Display Edible Arrangements • Mixed arrangements of hydrangeas, anemones, jasmine, and clematis—with edible elements such as kale, black olives on the branch, artichokes, and miniature eggplants—contributed an informal, fall vibe to the tables.

>>> The Last Detail • Re-embroidered lace flowers over a latte-colored silk lining added a botanical touch to the bride's Monique Lhuillier gown.

>> Just Rosemarried • A sprig of rosemary tied with burgundy velvet was placed on each napkin to complement the Italian dinner menu and the wine-colored table linens.

/>> Fired Up • Flames soared in the subway-tiled fireplace, lending a cozy, dinner-party feel to the reception.

Monumental Love • The bride and groom posed for photos before the wedding around some of NYC's most famous landmarks, including the Washington Square Arch.

>>> Take the Cake • A cast-iron urn with hydrangeas and trailing greenery towered over the favors—wedding cake cookies.

La Dolce Vita • Reflecting the Tuscan theme, pumpkin, raspberry, and chocolate-hazelnut gelato was served from an antique gelato cart during the after-hours of the reception.

Big Yellow Taxi • In a vintage New York taxicab rented for the occasion, the couple stole a quiet moment en route to the reception.
